Repeater Trailer Mast Upgrade C^2

- [Luke] Primary concern with the existing trailer is safety. Threads to bolt mast to the trailer have shreaded. A ratchet strap is currently used to secure the mast to the trailer.
- [Phil] Q: Could we re-thread bolts / holes?
 - **[Luke] A:** Yes, but the integrity is of concern. There are also other issues with the existing mast (currently does not fully extend).
- [Luke] Due to budgetary constraints, we will wait until after Scout Hike to finalize a purchase.
- [Douglas] Q: What about weight carrying capacity of the trailer?
 - **[Luke] A:** The plan would be to remove the trailer box to re-balance the trailer, with the weight of the new mast on the front. Batteries at the back will ensure balanced weight.

 - **[Luke] A:** Its possible. Lets investigate further for a full kit-out out-of-band of the meeting.
